**BY-LAWS OF BOYNTON
LODGE NO 236**

PROPOSED CHANGES

DUES INCREASE

4.01 - Dues - Every member of this Lodge shall pay to the Secretary, for the use of the Lodge, the sum of \$ 135.00 per annum for 2011 and \$ 185.00 for 2012 and thereafter which shall include the Grand Lodge Per-Capita Assessment, which sum shall be due and payable in advance on or before the first day of each Masonic Year, which Masonic Year shall begin on the 28th day of December of each year and end on the 27th day of December of the following year, except life members, honorary members and those members whose dues are remitted in accordance with Masonic Law.
