This month, we will send out the 2025 dues notices. If you haven't paid your 2025 dues yet, please do so as soon as possible, as the lodge depends on your support. If you are behind, you risk suspension for non-payment. If you're facing financial difficulties, please contact me right away so we can assist you.

As a reminder, you can pay with credit card using the Amity app, but know there is approx. a 3% surcharge for processing the payment through them. I would recommend sending the lodge a check through your bill pay system, Zelle, Venmo (or the like) and include the surcharge that you would have spent to LYPMGC (it is shown as optional on your dues notice and goes to our Masonic Home) along with your dues.

As we finish this year, we are planning for 2026, including the degree schedule, picnics, and member-requested improvements. The finance committee will meet this month and next to prepare the financial statement and budget, which will be shared at our January 22, 2026 meeting.

If you want to run for an elected officer position in 2026, please submit your nomination paperwork to the secretary before the lodge opens on November 13. All required education must be recorded before you can be nominated. If you're unsure about your qualifications, please reach out to me soon. Our elections will be held on December 10, 2025.
